The Historical Institute asked the students to develop a website where authorized users could see and read the pages of the Cronaca Pedrazzi.

The Cronaca Pedrazzi is a diary written by Adamo Pedrazzi during the second world war about the events that happened in Modena.

The login process is managed by a logic OR gate, as shown in the table.

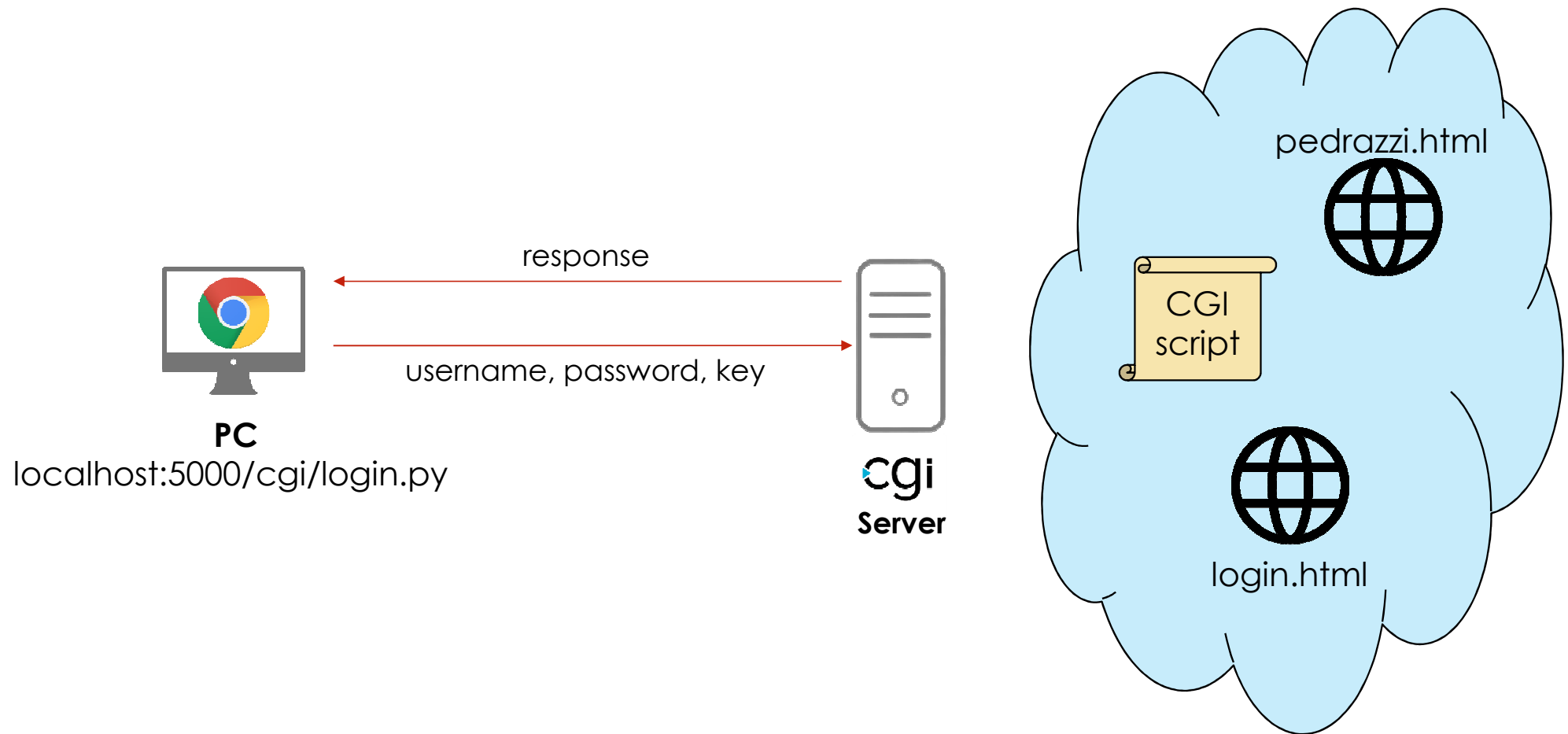
